POST OPERATIVE SURGICAL SHEET

The bandage that has been placed over your wound can be removed in 24 hours. Once the bandage has been removed, you can shower using antibacterial soap, and pat dry. You may rebandage the area, but it is not required.

PRESCRIPTIONS – If you have received an antibiotic prescription, take it as directed until all the medication is gone. If you have received a prescription for pain, take it as directed (when needed). Unless prescribed by your doctor, do not take products containing aspirin or ibuprofen until your sutures have been removed.

ICE PACKS – To minimize bruising and swelling, apply an ice pack over the bandaged site (15 minutes on, 15 minutes off) during the first 24 hour period following your surgical procedure. Elevating the area can also reduce swelling.
